Collaborative Leaders

The **ISO 44001 Collaborative Leaders** course is a four-day small group course delivered in-person by Institute for Collaborative Working (ICW) Australia. Course participants are provided with in-depth knowledge of ISO 44001 and Collaborative Working as a business discipline, to develop deep understanding of collaborative business relationship management.

Course content includes in-depth and interactive briefing on Collaborative Working and ISO 44001. During the course participants are given the opportunity to apply the learning into their own business scenarios. Participants are encouraged to work together to develop ideas, expand knowledge and expertise, and build on experiences. The course also includes professional development feedback.

The Collaborative Leaders course is recommended for:

- Leaders responsible for their organisation's capabilities to establish and maintain effective Collaborative Working,
- Leaders of significant projects and major initiatives,
- Leaders of innovative collaborative efforts, and
- Leaders responsible for achieving ISO 44001 certification.

Course Outcomes

Participants will be equipped to facilitate ISO 44001 implementation within their organisation and to deploy ISO 44001 jointly with partners across projects and programs.

By the end of the course, candidates are expected to:

- Understand why relationships are important in delivering business strategy,
- Understand the value of a pan-industry framework to enhance engagement and provide a benchmark for collaborative capability,
- Be able to link collaborative working to organisational objectives and constraints to promote both effective engagement and risk management,
- Be able to assess an organisation's internal capability as a prerequisite to external engagement,
- Be able to develop processes for the selection of partners,
- Understand how to facilitate the development of an appropriate delivery model and contracting arrangements for organisations seeking to engage partners in collaborative relationships,
- Understand the importance of continuous improvement, innovation and value creation to develop the relationship to its fullest extent,
- Appreciate the importance of effective measurement and monitoring of performance and the relationship, and
- Understand the critical need to define the exit strategy to facilitate controlled disengagement.

Accreditation

The ISO 44001 Collaborative Leaders course is awarded by ICW UK based on successful completion. Course assessment includes: a multiple choice test (based on pre-reading - see below), a three-hour closed book exam assessed by Warwick University, a group exercise on resource allocation, and an individual case study presentation.

The Collaborative Leaders course is held over four full days. Course content for each day runs from approximately 9:00 am to 5:00 pm. Days 1 and 2 include opportunity for after-session study with the ICW Australia Trainer. A group dinner is held on Day 3 of the course.
